Petitioner has failed to comply with the Court's order to 17 (1) perfect his application to proceed in forma pauperis ("IFP"), or (2) pay the filing fee of 18 \$5.00. He also has failed to file a petition. Accordingly, this habeas action is DISMISSED 19 without prejudice for failure to respond to the Court's order and for failure to prosecute under 20 Federal Rule of Civil Procedure 41(b). Because this dismissal is without prejudice, petitioner 21 may move to reopen the action. Any motion to reopen **must** contain (1) a petition using this 22 Court's form, <u>and</u> (2) a complete IFP application <u>or</u> (3) full payment for the filing fee.
