20	parties to brief the issue. The City shall have 14 days to file an opening brief that is no
21	longer than 15 pages. Levin shall have 14 days after the opening brief is due to file a
22	response that is no longer than 15 pages. The City shall have 7 days after the response is due to file a reply that is no longer than 8 pages.
