In each of these actions, plaintiff has failed to comply with the Court’s order to (1) file a complete application to proceed *in forma pauperis* (“IFP”), or (2) pay the full filing fee of \$400.00. Accordingly, the action is DISMISSED without prejudice for failing to respond to the Court’s order, and for failure to prosecute, *see* Fed. R. Civ. P. 41(b). Because this dismissal is without prejudice, plaintiff may move to reopen each action. In each action, the Clerk shall enter judgment in favor of defendants, and close the file.
