On April 20, 2015, the parties filed a stipulation to dismiss this entire action with prejudice. Dkt. 21. The parties stipulate that Plaintiff Sherri Cruz “dismiss[es] without prejudice, the class action claims asserted in the lawsuit.” Id.
