1 aforesaid petition, be served upon said respondent in accordance with Rule 4 of the Federal
2 Rules of Civil Procedure at least thirty-five (35) days before the return date of this Order
3 above specified; and it is further

4 ORDERED that within twenty-one (21) days before the return date of this Order,
5 respondent may file and serve a written response to the petition, supported by appropriate
6 affidavit(s) or declaration(s) in conformance with 28 U.S.C. § 1746, as well as any motion
7 respondent desires to make, that the petitioners may file and serve a written reply to such
8 response, if any, within fourteen (14) days before the return date of this Order; that all
9 motions and issues raised by the pleadings will be considered on the return date of this
10 Order, and only those issues raised by motion or brought into controversy by the responsive
11 pleadings and supported by affidavit(s) or declaration(s) will be considered at the return of
12 this Order, and any uncontested allegation in the petition will be considered admitted; and it
13 is further

14 ORDERED that each party file written consent to the jurisdiction of this Court or a
15 written request for reassignment to a district judge as soon as possible but no later than the
16 deadlines specified in Civil Local Rule 73-1(a).

17 IT IS SO ORDERED.
