1	WHEREAS, on March 24, 2016, the Parties resolved their dispute through a mutually		
2	agreeable Settlement and Release Agreement Between Kathleen Kottom, Albert Dan Walker,		
3	Nature's World, L.L.C., and the Paul and Kathleen Kottom Living Trust ("Settlement Agreement")		
4	and Assignment of Membership Interest of Nature's World, L.L.C.;		
5	NOW, THEREFORE, the Parties agree and stipulate as follows:		
6	1. Pursuant to the express terms of the Parties' Settlement Agreement, the Parties jointly		
7	stipulate to the dismissal of this Action with prejudice.		
8	2. The Parties agree that Judge Laurel Beeler of the United States District Court for the		
9	Northern District of California (or another judge in the same Court, should Judge Beeler be		
10	unavailable) shall maintain jurisdiction to enforce the Settlement Agreement. No other court, except

12	courts of appeal, has authority to adjudicate any controversy over the Parties' Settlement Agreement		
13	or any other subsequent controversy between and among the Parties regarding Nature's World,

16	3. Each Party shall bear his or her own attorneys' fees and costs.
