LIZARRAGA, Warden, 12 Respondent. 13 14 Petitioner, an inmate at Mule Creek State Prison in Amador County, California, filed this pro se 15 action for a writ of habeas corpus pursuant to 28 U.S.C. § 2254 to challenge his conviction from the 16 Sacramento County Superior Court. The county in which he is confined and the county in which he 17 was convicted are both located within the venue of the Eastern District of California. Venue is 18 proper in a habeas action in either the district of confinement or the district of conviction, 28 U.S.C. 19 § 2241(d), although a petition challenging a conviction or the sentence imposed is preferably heard 20 in the district of conviction. See N. D. Cal. Habeas L.R. 2254-3(b). Because petitioner was 21 convicted in the Eastern District of California, pursuant to 28 U.S.C. § 1406(a) and Habeas L.R. 22 2254-3(b), and in the interest of justice, this action is TRANSFERRED to the United States District 23 Court for the Eastern District of California. The clerk shall transfer this matter forthwith. 24 IT IS SO ORDERED. 25
