2	Plaintiffs Rachel Hochstetler and Cirena Torres, Defendant and Cross-Claimant		
3	Pacific Gateway Concessions LLC ("PGC"), and Cross-Defendant Point Solutions, LLC		
4	("PS") hereby stipulate as follows:		
5	Recitals		
6	1. The Initial Case Management Conference in this action has been continued		
7	three times to allow the parties an opportunity to negotiate settlement. (Docket 24, 29,		
8	32.) Plaintiffs and PGC reached agreement on settlement of the putative class action,		
9	which was memorialized in a Memorandum of Understanding of Settlement ("MOU")		
10	signed on June 8, 2015. Plaintiffs and PGC have since negotiated and executed a detailed		
11	Stipulated Settlement Agreement and Release ("Class Settlement Agreement"). Pursuant		
12	to Federal Rule of Civil Procedure 23(e), Plaintiffs will shortly file a motion seeking the		
13	Court's preliminary approval of the Class Settlement Agreement.		
14	2. PGC and PS have reached agreement on the major details of the settlement		
15	of PGC's cross-claim for indemnity and contribution and for breach of contract. PGC and		
16	PS anticipate that a formal settlement agreement should be signed shortly, pursuant to		
17	which PGC's cross-claim would be dismissed in conjunction with the Court's final		
18	approval of the Class Settlement Agreement.		
19	3. In the interest of efficient case management and minimizing the burden of		
20	the action on the Court's resources, the parties agree that the August 31, 2015 Case		
21	Management Conference should be, at the Court's discretion, either: (i) continued from		
22	August 31, 2015 for 60 days in order to permit Plaintiffs to file the motion for preliminary		
23	approval of the Class Settlement Agreement, then vacated once the motion is filed; or (ii)		
24	vacated now.
