WHEREAS, two putative class actions under Sections 10(b) and 20(a) of the Securities Exchange Act of 1934 (the "Exchange Act") were filed on March 14, 2014 and March 28, 2014 in the Northern District of California; and

WHEREAS, in accordance with the provisions of Section 21D(a)(3)(A)(i) of the Exchange Act, on March 14, 2014, first-filed plaintiff Rohan Kishtagari published notice via Business Wire, a widely circulated national business-oriented wire service, advising purported class members of their right to move this Court to be appointed Lead Plaintiff; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 21D of the Exchange Act, any purported class member desiring to be appointed Lead Plaintiff was required to have filed a motion for such appointment on or before May 13, 2014; and

WHEREAS, Vinod Patel ("Patel") filed a timely motion to be appointed Lead Plaintiff; and WHEREAS, Patel has the largest financial interest in the relief sought by the putative class and otherwise best satisfies the requirements of Section 21D of the Exchange Act and Rule 23 of the Federal Rules of Civil Procedure; and

WHEREAS, in accordance with Section 21D(a)(3)(B)(v) of the Exchange Act, 15 U.S.C. § 78u-4(a)(3)(B)(v), Patel seeks approval of his selection of Faruqi & Faruqi, LLP to serve as Lead Counsel;

AND NOW THIS 30th day of June, 2014, the Court having considered Vinod Patel's Motion for Consolidation, Appointment as Lead Plaintiff, and Approval of Lead Counsel and all supporting documents, it is hereby ORDERED as follows:

CONSOLIDATION

- 1. The motion of Patel to consolidate the above-captioned actions ("Consolidated Action") is GRANTED.
- 2. Pursuant to Rule 42(a) of the Federal Rules of Civil Procedure, the Consolidated Action is to be consolidated for all purposes, including, without limitation, discovery, pretrial proceedings, and trial.

Pursuant to Section 21D of the Exchange Act, 15 U.S.C. § 78u-4(3)(B)(v), Faruqi & 9. Faruqi, LLP is approved to serve the Lead Plaintiff and the putative Class as Lead Counsel. IT IS SO ORDERED. DATED: June 30, 2014
