18	Defendants have filed an <i>ex parte</i> application to schedule a case management
19	conference for the purpose of discussing continuances of several deadlines, including the
20	deadline to file dispositive motions, the close of fact discovery, and the trial date (Dkt. No.
21 22	104). Defendants cite concerns that the deadline to file dispositive motions and the close of fact
22 23	discovery will both occur before the opt-in period ends, and trial is scheduled to begin five
23 24	weeks after the opt-in period ends. This time pressure resulted from the fact that conditional
25	certification and notice were delayed by discovery relating to defendants' motion to compel
26	arbitration, issues pertaining to the FAA transportation-workers exemption, and further disputes relating to the scope of the conditionally-certified collective action.
