13 Before the Court is the Report and Recommendation, filed sua sponte, by  
14 Magistrate Judge Kandis A. Westmore on December 9, 2014, by which filing said  
15 magistrate judge recommends the above-titled action be remanded to state court for lack of  
16 federal question jurisdiction and requests the action be reassigned to a district judge for  
17 purposes of determining said jurisdictional question. That same date, the above-titled  
18 action was reassigned to the undersigned. Thereafter, on December 10, 2014, plaintiff

23 remand are presently pending before the Court in the above-referenced Report and
