ORDER DISMISSING ACTION

Plaintiff, having been granted leave to proceed in forma pauperis ("IFP"), now seeks service of process upon the named defendants of his First Amended Complaint ("FAC") and related documents. The prior complaint was dismissed for failure to comply with Rule 8's pleading standards and failure to set forth a cognizable claim. The FAC, over ninety pages in length, again falls short of meeting these requirements. In light of the Court's continuing duty to dismiss any case in which a party seeks leave to proceed in forma pauperis if the Court determines that the action (1) is frivolous or malicious; (2) fails to state a claim on which relief may be granted; or (3) seeks monetary relief against a defendant who is immune from such relief, see 28 U.S.C. § 1915(e)(2), this action must be dismissed with prejudice.
