The time to file an opposition has passed. The Court finds that the actions "concern substantially the same parties, property, 16 transaction, or event," and that "[i]t appears likely that there will be an unduly burdensome 17 duplication of labor and expense or conflicting results if the cases are conducted before different 18 Judges." Civ. L.R. 3-12(a). Accordingly, the Court determines that 4:15-cv-01544-KAW is 19 related to 3:15-cv-00941-HSG and reassigns it to the undersigned for all future proceedings. 20 21 The parties are instructed that any future filings in the reassigned case are to bear the initials of the undersigned immediately after the case number. The case management conference 22 23 in the reassigned case will be rescheduled by the Court. The parties shall adjust the dates for the conference, disclosures and report required by Federal Rules of Civil Procedure 16 and 26 24 25 accordingly. 26 // 27 //
