 FEES AND COSTS

1 **STIPULATION**

2 Pursuant to Civil L.R. 6-2, Plaintiffs Sierra Club and California Communities Against Toxics
3 and Defendant Gina McCarthy, Administrator of the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency
4 (“EPA”) stipulate as follows:

5 1. By decision dated March 15, 2016, the Court entered judgment in favor of Plaintiffs.
6 The Court provided that “Plaintiffs may file any appropriate motion for attorneys’ fees and costs
7 within 30 days.” Dkt. No. 41, at 1; *see also* Civil L.R. 54-1(providing deadline for filing bill of
8 costs); Civil L.R. 54-5 (providing deadline for moving for attorneys’ fees unless Court orders
9 otherwise).

10 2. Plaintiffs and Defendant wish to attempt to resolve Plaintiffs’ claim for fees and costs
11 without the need for further litigation. The parties believe that additional time is necessary to
12 ascertain whether they can reach an agreement as to fees and costs.

13 3. Therefore, Plaintiffs and Defendant stipulate to enlarge the time for filing a motion
14 for fees and costs so that they may have additional time to discuss an informal settlement of the
15 issue. Plaintiffs and Defendant hereby stipulate to a 60-day extension, which extends the deadline
16 for filing a motion for fees and costs from April 14, 2016 to June 13, 2016. A declaration in support
17 of this stipulation is attached.

18 4. Plaintiffs attest that concurrence in the filing of this Stipulation has been obtained
19 from counsel for Defendant pursuant to Civil L.R. 5-1(i)(3).
