Accordingly, the Court will vacate the trial date, currently scheduled for May 24, 2016. 13 The Court orders Defendant to provide Plaintiff with a form of proposed judgment by May 14 15 11, 2016. Plaintiff will then have five court days from the receipt of the proposed judgment to either approve it as to form or object to it. If Plaintiff approves the proposed judgment, Defendant 16 shall file the proposed judgment with Plaintiff's counsel's signature, indicating Plaintiff's 17 approval. If Plaintiff objects, Defendant shall file the proposed judgment along with Plaintiff's 18 objections, which are not to exceed five pages. Defendant may also file a response to Plaintiff's 19 objections, which response shall not exceed five pages. That filing is due five court days after 20 Plaintiff's objections are due. 21 If Plaintiff neither approves the form of order nor serves objections on Defendant, the 22 23 Court will sign the proposed judgment in the form provided by Defendant.
