**CASE MANAGEMENT SCHEDULING
ORDER**

14 Pursuant to Rule 16(b) of the Federal Rules of Civil Procedure, the parties attended a Case
15 Management Conference on July 9, 2015. After considering the Joint Case Management
16 Statement submitted by the parties and consulting with the attorneys of record for the parties and
17 good cause appearing, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED THAT:

18 1. DISCOVERY.

19 By agreement of the parties, no discovery shall be exchanged prior to the completion of
20 private mediation scheduled to occur in October 2015.

21 2. DISCOVERY DISPUTES.

22 Discovery disputes will be referred to a Magistrate Judge. After the parties have met and
23 conferred, the parties shall prepare a joint letter of not more than 8 pages explaining the dispute.
24 Up to 12 pages of attachments may be added. The joint letter must be electronically filed under
25 the Civil Events category of "Motions and Related Filings >Motions--General > Discovery Letter
26 Brief." The Magistrate Judge to whom the matter is assigned will advise the parties of how that
27 Judge intends to proceed. The Magistrate Judge may issue a ruling, order more formal briefing, or
28 set a telephone conference or a hearing. After a Magistrate Judge has been assigned, all further
discovery matters shall be filed pursuant to that Judge's procedures.



3. CROSS-MOTIONS FOR SUMMARY JUDGMENT.

- a. On or before January 15, 2016, the parties will exchange cross-motions for summary judgment.
