FOR A STAY**



The Court has read the parties' submissions regarding the Hawaii litigation and read Paragraph 19 of the partnership agreement.

The defendant is hereby granted permission to bring a motion for summary judgment directed to Total Recall's authority to maintain this lawsuit without prejudice to a later summary judgment motion on other issues.
