

The Court has received the parties' stipulated request to continue all dates for four months while Wells Fargo considers plaintiff for a loan modification. There is no reason why the parties cannot continue to litigate while the loan modification process plays out. The undersigned judge has learned the hard way that extending dates as requested simply allows the parties to focus on something else. The request to continue all dates for four months is **DENIED**. If, however, Wells Fargo represents to the Court, in writing, that there is a high chance plaintiff will be approved for a loan modification and plaintiff agrees, in writing, that such a modification would definitely settle the case, then the Court would consider a three week extension of all dates. Meanwhile, all dates remain in place.
