The parties submitted their Further Joint Case Management Statement on Limited Issues (Dkt. No. 49¹) on June 9, 2016, and appeared before the Court for a further case management conference on June 16, 2016. As set forth in the joint submission, the parties have agreed to the issues on which Defendant will move for early summary judgment. (Id. at 2.) At the conference, Plaintiff's counsel indicated that Plaintiff will be available for deposition in July; Defendant is not required to depose Plaintiff as to any issues outside of those for which it seeks early summary judgment. However, should Plaintiff be deposed a second time in this case, the seven-hour time limit for depositions shall apply (see Fed. R. Civ. P. 30(d)(1)), and Defendant shall accommodate Plaintiff's schedule such that she will not be required to miss work or take any vacation days to attend deposition.

Defendant will file its motion for early summary judgment by July 21, 2016. Accordingly, the Court sets forth the following briefing and hearing schedule for Defendant's motion:

Defendant's opening brief: July 21, 2016

Plaintiff's opposition brief: August 4, 2016
