

by the deadline. Accordingly, this federal civil rights action is DISMISSED without prejudice for failing to respond to the Court's order, and for failure to prosecute, see Fed. R. Civ. P. 41(b). Because this dismissal is without prejudice, plaintiff may move to reopen 19 the action. Any such motion <u>must</u> contain an amended complaint that complies with the 20 instructions set forth in the order dismissing the complaint with leave to amend (Docket No. 8). 22

The Clerk shall enter judgment in favor of defendants, and close the file.
