The Court hereby rescinds the 20 custody order requiring Batinovich to self-surrender at noon today, and the Court will not issue 21 a bench warrant (Dkt. No. 40). To be clear, the preliminary injunction dated November 17, 22 2015 remains in effect (Dkt. No. 19). 23 24 IT IS SO ORDERED. 25 26
