23	Francisco within two weeks of this order. The Court will address Plaintiff's charts		
24	and the deposition and testimony of Plaintiff's paralegal at the pretrial conference		
25	on August 24, 2017.		
26	4. The Court will address Grubhub	4. The Court will address Grubhub's ROGS concerning Plaintiff's tax information	
27	and whether Plaintiff should be ordered to respond at the pretrial conference on		
28	August 24, 2017.
