- 7 1. On November 16, 2015, Plaintiff filed a complaint alleging violations of his civil
8 rights pursuant to 42 U.S.C. §§ 1983 and 1988. *See* ECF Doc. No. 1.
- 9 2. The response to the complaint by Defendants CONTRA COSTA COUNTY
10 SERGEANT DAVID ADAMS, CONTRA COSTA COUNTY SHERIFF'S
11 DEPUTIES JEFF JACKSON, J. KIRKHAM, DAVID LONDONO, TYLER
12 NELSON, KATIE RHOE, A. ROSSI, and TRAVIS WRANGHAM, LAFAYETTE
13 POLICE SERGEANT D. NUGENT, and LAFAYETTE POLICE OFFICERS
14 BRAD IMHOFF and B. PARKER, is currently due on January 26, 2016.
- 15 3. The Contra Costa County Counsel's Office represents all of the above referenced
16 defendants, and CONTRA COSTA COUNTY SHERIFF'S DEPUTIES A.
17 CONIGLIO and THOMAS HENDERSON. Service of the summons and complaint
18 has not been completed at this time as to Defendants A. CONIGLIO and THOMAS
19 HENDERSON.
- 20 4. Therefore, the parties to this stipulation have stipulated and agreed that a response
21 to the complaint by Defendants CONTRA COSTA COUNTY SERGEANT
22 DAVID ADAMS, CONTRA COSTA COUNTY SHERIFF'S DEPUTIES JEFF
23 JACKSON, J. KIRKHAM, DAVID LONDONO, TYLER NELSON, KATIE
24 RHOE, A. ROSSI, and TRAVIS WRANGHAM, LAFAYETTE POLICE
25 SERGEANT D. NUGENT, and LAFAYETTE POLICE OFFICERS BRAD
26 IMHOFF and B. PARKER, shall be due no later than February 26, 2016. Pursuant
27 to Civil Local Rule 6-1(a), the parties attest that the requested extension of time to
28 answer or otherwise respond to the complaint will not alter the date of any event or

1 any deadline already fixed by Court order.
