MINUTE ORDER NOTING DISMISSAL



13 Plaintiff Harley Milne has filed a Notice of Voluntary Dismissal dated February 29, 2016,
14 stating that Plaintiff wishes to dismiss his claims against Defendant HireRight, LLC with
15 prejudice. ECF No. 31. “The plaintiff may dismiss some or all of the defendants . . . through a
16 Rule 41(a)(1) notice.” Wilson v. City of San Jose, 111 F.3d 688, 692 (9th Cir. 1997). Because the
17 Notice was filed before an answer or motion for summary judgment has been served on Plaintiff,
18 dismissal is effective without court order pursuant to Federal Rule of Civil Procedure
19 41(a)(1)(A)(i).

21 All claims between Plaintiff and HireRight, LLC have been dismissed with prejudice. The
22 Clerk is directed to terminate HireRight, LLC as a party in this case.
