ECF No. 34. "The plaintiff may dismiss some or all of the defendants . . . 14 15 through a Rule 41(a)(1) notice." Wilson v. City of San Jose, 111 F.3d 688, 692 (9th Cir. 1997). 16 Dismissal is effective without court order pursuant to Federal Rule of Civil Procedure 17 41(a)(1)(A)(ii). 18 All claims between Plaintiffs and Chase have been dismissed without prejudice.
