**DISMISSAL WITHOUT PREJUDICE  
FOR FAILURE TO PROSECUTE**

On August 16, 2016, the Court issued an Order for plaintiff Deborah Lagutaris to file a motion for summary judgment or for remand. Dkt. No. 17. The Order set a deadline of September 6, 2016, and advised Ms. Lagutaris that if she did not meet the deadline her case may be dismissed for failure to prosecute. *Id.* at 1. On September 9, 2016, the Court issued an Order to show cause why this matter should not be dismissed without prejudice for failure to prosecute, by filing a motion for summary judgment or remand no later than September 30, 2016. Dkt. No. 18. Ms. Lagutaris was again advised that if she failed to do so, the Court would dismiss this Social Security appeal without prejudice for failure to prosecute. *Id.*

Ms. Lagutaris has filed nothing since issuance of the Order to Show Cause, nor has she contacted the Court to request additional time to file. Accordingly, this action is DISMISSED without prejudice for failure to prosecute. All calendared dates and deadlines are VACATED. The Clerk shall close the file.
