

17 On April 29, 2016, defendants County of Alameda, Nancy O'Malley, John Paul 18 Williams, and Eddie Bermudez electronically filed their "Reply Re Motion to Dismiss 19 Plaintiffs' Complaint (FRCP Rule 12(b)(6)) and, in the Alternative, Motion for More Definite 20 Statement (FRCP Rule 12(e))," and defendant Fernando Cubangbang electronically filed 21 his Reply "in Support of Request for Stay and Motion to Dismiss." Defendants have 22 violated the Civil Local Rules of this District and the Court's Standing Orders, however, by 23 failing "to provide for chambers a paper copy of each document that is electronically filed 24 ... marked 'Chambers Copy'." See Civil L.R. 5-1(e)(7); see also Standing Orders For Civil 25 Cases Assigned to The Honorable Maxine M. Chesney ¶ 2.
