**ORDER OF DISMISSAL WITH
PREJUDICE**

13 Plaintiff Steven Wayne Bonilla is a state prisoner who alleges that the United States
14 Attorney General's Office violated Bonilla's constitutional rights. Bonilla has been disqualified
15 from proceeding *in forma pauperis* under 28 U.S.C. § 1915(g) unless he is "under imminent
16 danger of serious physical injury" at the time he filed his complaint. 28 U.S.C. 1915(g); *In re*
17 *Steven Bonilla*, No. C 11-3180 CW (PR); *Bonilla v. Dawson*, No. C 13-0951 CW (PR).

18 The allegations in this complaint do not show that Bonilla was in imminent danger at the
19 time of filing. Therefore, he may not proceed *in forma pauperis*. Furthermore, he may not
20 proceed even if he pays the filing fee because, even liberally construed, the allegations do not state
21 a claim for which relief may be granted and amendment would be futile.

22 Accordingly, this complaint is dismissed with prejudice. The Clerk of the Court shall enter
23 a separate judgment and close the file.
