21	Motions were filed. <u>See</u> Civil Local Rule 7-3(a). Those opposition papers are now untimely.
22	Plaintiff is hereby ORDERED to SHOW CAUSE by Thursday, June 2, 2016, why his case
23	should not be dismissed for failure to prosecute, pursuant to Federal Rule of Civil Procedure
24	41(b).
