16	1. ALTERNATIVE DISPUTE RESOLUTION.	
17	MEDIATION: The parties are hereby referred to the court's ADR department for the	
18	purpose of engaging in mediation to take place, ideally, within the next 90 days.	
19	2. DISCOVERY.	
20	To the extent discovery is warranted, all such discovery must be completed on or before	
21	January 27, 2017.	
22	3. DISCOVERY DISPUTES.	
23	Discovery disputes, including those over the availability or scope of discovery, will be	
24	referred to a Magistrate Judge. After the parties have met and conferred, the parties shall prepare	
25	a joint letter of not more than 5 pages explaining the dispute. Up to 12 pages of attachments may	
26	be added. The joint letter must be electronically filed under the Civil Events category of "Motions	
27	and Related Filings > MotionsGeneral > Discovery Letter Brief." The Magistrate Judge to	
28	whom the matter is assigned will advise the parties of how that Judge intends to proceed. The	

Magistrate Judge may issue a ruling, order more formal briefing, or set a telephone conference or a hearing. After a Magistrate Judge has been assigned, all further discovery matters shall be filed pursuant to that Judge's procedures. 4. TRIAL DATE.
