WHEREAS, on the evening prior to the depositions, defense counsel was informed that Plaintiff would be dismissing the case with prejudice and that the depositions should be cancelled. Based upon the representation that the case was going to be dismissed, the depositions were cancelled.

WHEREAS, on the afternoon of June 27, 2016, defense counsel was informed that Plaintiff would not be dismissing this case and that he would be requesting substitution of counsel.

WHEREAS, given the unusual situation the parties find themselves in, the parties agree that the deadline to complete the one-hour depositions should be continued for 30 days.

WHEREAS, a 30-day extension of the one-hour depositions will allow Plaintiff to submit a request for substitution of counsel, retain new counsel, and will not require the extension of any other deadline in this matter.
