ORDER DENYING MOTION TO QUASH SUBPOENA

Defendant.

Malibu Media served a third-party subpoena on defendant's Internet service provider, Comcast. Defendant filed a motion to quash or modify the subpoena on the grounds that he was a customer of Malibu Media's and because compliance would invade his privacy. His motion is not accompanied by a sworn record and did not include any of his contact information. The Court ordered defendant to file a notice indicating his name and address to be filed under seal for the Court's eyes only, but defendant never responded.

Defendant's denial of liability is not a basis for quashing the subpoena, and any privacy interest he has in the subpoenaed information is far outweighed by Malibu Media's need to identify the proper defendant in this action, which can only be done with this subpoena.

Accordingly, defendant's motion to quash is **DENIED**.
