
**ORDER GRANTING IN PART AND
DENYING IN PART MOTION FOR
SUMMARY JUDGMENT**

Re: Dkt. No. 33

Defendant United Parcel Service, Inc.’s motion for summary judgment (dkt. 33) is GRANTED as to Plaintiff Tammi Fuqua’s fourth and eighth claims, for disability discrimination based on a theory of disparate impact and for violation of section 201 of the California Labor Code, and as to her prayer for punitive damages. The motion is otherwise DENIED.¹ A detailed order explaining the Court’s reasoning will follow.
