ORDER REGARDING INCOMPLETE IFP APPLICATION

This action was dismissed without prejudice on April 25, 2016 because plaintiff did not pay the filing fee or file an in forma pauperis (IFP) application. On April 26, 2016, plaintiff filed a Certificate of Funds completed and signed by an authorized prison officer as well as a prison trust account statement detailing transactions for the last six months.
