Plaintiff also filed a motion for a temporary 18 restraining order (TRO) seeking relief, including to prohibit Defendants from violating the anti-19 fraud provisions of federal securities law and from directly or indirectly soliciting any person to 20 buy or sell securities; to freeze the assets of the Bivonas, the Mazzolas, and Felix Investments; and 21 to appoint an independent monitor. The SEC shall file a declaration confirming service, and explaining how service was effectuated. Defendants and Relief Defendants shall have until today, March 22, 2016 at 6:00 P.M. PST to file opposition papers.
