REMANDING CASE**


Re: Dkt. No. 7

On May 3, 2016, Magistrate Judge Laurel Beeler issued a Report and Recommendation recommending the remand of this unlawful detainer action to Alameda County Superior Court because of a lack of subject matter jurisdiction. Dkt. No. 7. Objections to Judge Beeler’s recommendation to remand were due by May 20, 2016. Federal Rule of Civil Procedure 72(b); Civ. Local Rule 72-3. As of today’s date, no objections have been filed.¹

Having reviewed the matter, the Court ADOPTS Judge Beeler’s Report and Recommendation in whole. For the reasons expressed therein, this case is REMANDED to Alameda County Superior Court.
