15	A prior order dated May 16 granted the parties' joint request to further stay the hearing
16	on respondents' motion to dismiss pending mediation proceedings on June 30 (Dkt. No. 65).
17	That order required the parties to "submit another joint status report updating the Court on the
18	progress of mediation by JULY 3 AT NOON" and specifically warned that "[f]urther continuances
19	past July 3 are unlikely to be granted."
20	As of the date of this order, no further status report has been filed by either side,
21	although the docket reflects that the parties participated in mediation before Judge Nandor
22	Vadas on June 30 but were unable to settle the case (see Dkt. No. 68). The parties are hereby
23	ordered to SHOW CAUSE in writing by JULY 14 AT NOON why the stay should not be lifted and a
24	further hearing set on respondents' pending motion to dismiss (Dkt. No. 35).
