It will be easier to try the case than to sort through yet another mish-mash of 18 finger-pointing. The Court is disturbed the Spotify failed to disclose plaintiff's usage after the 19 trial period in its Rule 26 initial disclosures. To make up for that, plaintiff may take up to two 20 two-hour depositions and propound three narrowly drawn document requests so long as plaintiff 21 pursues them in the next seven calendar days. Defendant must oblige the requests. The hearing 22 on November 8 is hereby **VACATED**. 23 24 25
