23 Pursuant to the Case Management Conference Order (DN 19), Plaintiff Hoopa Valley
 24 Tribe, Defendants U.S. Bureau of Reclamation and National Marine Fisheries Service (“Federal
 25 Defendants”), and Defendant-Intervenors Klamath Water Users Association, Sunnyside
 26 Irrigation District, and Ben DuVal hereby agree and stipulate to continue the Case Management
 27 Conference in the above-captioned matter in light of the filing (on October 5, 2016) of Federal
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1 Defendants' motion to dismiss or, in the alternative, to stay ("motion" (DN 33)).¹ The instant
