Nos. 10, 19). Plaintiff also sought to file similar materials under seal, 17 but untimely withdrew her motion. The materials sought to be sealed generally pertain to the 18 details of defendant's partnership agreement, which defendant requires its partners to keep 19 confidential. The sealing motions are **DENIED** as to the text of the two versions of the arbitration 20 provision and any discussion thereof, which are central to the instant motion to compel 21 arbitration and for which no good cause warrants sealing.
