5 1. WHEREAS, on September 13, 2016 the Court issued an Order Setting Initial
6 Case Management Conference for December 2, 2016 (Dkt. 16);

7 2. WHEREAS, on November 1, 2016, the Court reset the hearing on the Initial Case
8 Management Conference to January 27, 2017;

9 3. WHEREAS, on January 13, 2017, the Court continued the hearing on the Initial
10 Case Management Conference to March 3, 2017 due to the pending motion to dismiss (Dkt. 44);

11 4. WHEREAS, on February 24, 2017, the Court granted the motion to dismiss and

17 7. WHEREAS, Wells Fargo is preparing to file a motion for judgment on the
18 pleadings;

19 8. WHEREAS, the parties would like to avoid unnecessary costs and use of judicial
20 resources;

21 9. WHEREAS, the parties stipulate and request to continue the Case Management
22 Conference to August 25, 2017 to allow time for the court to hear the motion for judgment on the
23 pleadings;
