ORDER TO SHOW CAUSE

On September 23, 2016, Defendant Episcopal Community Services filed a Motion to Dismiss, with a noticed hearing date of December 1, 2016. Dkt. No. 7. Accordingly, the Court hereby **VACATES** the motion hearing and **ORDERS** Plaintiff Jerome Talley to show cause why this case should not be dismissed for failure to prosecute and failure to comply with court deadlines. Thus, it is imperative that the Court receive a written response by the deadline above.
