

18 The plaintiff filed a complaint against the defendant on September 26, 2016. (Complaint, ECF 19 No. 1.) Under the scheduling order at ECF No. 3, the date for completing service was November 20 25, 2016. Because the plaintiff did not file proof of service, on December 30, 2016 the court asked for an update by January 6, 2017. (ECF No. 7.) After receiving no word, the court again asked the 21 plaintiff to update the court about service no later than February 2, 2017. (ECF No. 8.) On both 22 occasions, the court warned that absent a showing of good cause, failing to timely serve a case can 23 result in the case being dismissed without prejudice under Federal Rule of Civil Procedure 4(m). 24 To date, the plaintiff has filed no proof that the defendant has been served or provided an 25 explanation about why there is good cause for not serving it. (See generally Docket.) 26 Accordingly, the court sets a hearing on February 16, 2017, at 11 a.m., for the plaintiff to show 27

cause why the case should not be dismissed under Rule 4(m) without prejudice for failure to serve
