**ORDER DIRECTING DEFENDANT  
AMERICAN HONDA FINANCE CORP.  
TO SUBMIT CHAMBERS COPY OF  
DOCUMENTS IN COMPLIANCE WITH  
CIVIL LOCAL RULES AND COURT'S  
STANDING ORDERS**

On December 8, 2016, defendant American Honda Finance Corporation ("Honda") electronically filed its "Answer" and "Certification of Interested Entities". Honda has violated the Civil Local Rules of this District and the Court's Standing Orders, however, by failing "to provide for chambers a paper copy of each document that is electronically filed . . . marked 'Chambers Copy.'" Honda is hereby ORDERED to comply with Civil Local Rule 5-1(e)(7) and the Court's Standing Orders by immediately submitting a chambers copy of the above-referenced documents. Honda is hereby advised that if it fails in the future to comply with the Court's Standing Orders to provide a chambers copy of each electronically filed document, the Court may impose sanctions, including, but not limited to, striking from the record any electronically filed document for which a chambers copy has not been timely provided to the Court.
