**ORDER DIRECTING DEFENDANT
WELLS FARGO BANK, N.A. TO
SUBMIT CHAMBERS COPY OF
DOCUMENT IN COMPLIANCE WITH
CIVIL LOCAL RULES AND COURT'S
STANDING ORDERS**

On March 24, 2017, defendant Wells Fargo Bank, N.A. ("Wells Fargo") electronically filed its "Statement of Recent Decisions." Wells Fargo has violated the Civil Local Rules of this District and the Court's Standing Orders, however, by failing "to provide for chambers a paper copy of each document that is electronically filed . . . marked 'Chambers Copy'." See Civil L.R. 5-1(e)(7); see also Standing Orders For Civil Cases Assigned to The Honorable Maxine M. Chesney ¶ 2.

Wells Fargo is hereby ORDERED to comply with Civil Local Rule 5-1(e)(7) and the Court's Standing Orders by immediately submitting a chambers copy of the above-referenced document. Wells Fargo is hereby advised that if it fails in the future to comply with the Court's Standing Orders to provide a chambers copy of each electronically filed document, the Court may impose sanctions, including, but not limited to, striking from the record any electronically filed document for which a chambers copy has not been timely provided to the Court.
