20 Plaintiff's *ex parte* application (Dkt. No. 60) is **GRANTED IN PART** only to the extent

22 promptly enough that plaintiff will have adequate time to complete her depositions and prepare
23 her reply brief, failing which the declarations in question may be stricken. Plaintiff's counsel
24 would be well-advised to take the schedule offered by defendants.
