ORDER TO SHOW CAUSE

On February 22, 2017, defendants Tesla Motors, Inc. and West Valley Staffing Group moved to dismiss plaintiff's complaint for failure to comply with pleading standards set forth in Northern District Local Rules, FRCP 8 and FRCP 12. Mot. at 1 (Dkt. No. 14). The case was reassigned to me on March 3, 2017, and the hearing on defendants' motion was reset for April 12, 2017. Dkt. No. 25. Plaintiff has yet to respond to the motion. On March 30, 2017, plaintiff filed a notice of address change and new phone number stating that he was homeless for several weeks. Dkt. No. 28. He is ordered to respond to defendants' motion by April 17, 2017, and the hearing is reset for May 3, 2017. If plaintiff fails to respond by the deadline, this action will be dismissed for failure to prosecute pursuant to Rule 41(b) of the Federal Rules of Civil Procedure.
