DISMISSING CASE**



12 The court has reviewed Magistrate Judge Sallie Kim's Report and Recommendation Re:
13 Application to Proceed in Forma Pauperis. The time for filing objections has passed and no
14 objections have been filed. The court finds the Report correct, well-reasoned and thorough, and
15 adopts it in every respect. Accordingly, plaintiff Jay L. Sellers' complaint is dismissed as frivolous
16 under 28 U.S.C. § 1915. Plaintiff will be granted leave to amend his complaint **within 20 days** of
17 the date below.

18 Plaintiff may wish to seek assistance with the Legal Help Center, a free service of the
19 Volunteer Legal Services Program, by calling (415) 782-8982 or signing up for an appointment on
20 the 15th Floor of the Courthouse, Room 2796. At the Legal Help Center, plaintiff may speak with
21 an attorney who may be able to provide basic legal help, but not legal representation. The Court
22 also urges plaintiff to obtain a copy of the Pro Se Handbook, available free of charge from the
23 Court's website (www.cand.uscourts.gov) or in the Clerk's Office on the 16th Floor, 450 Golden
24 Gate Avenue, San Francisco, CA. 94102.
