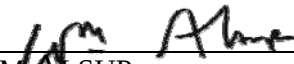
**ORDER EXTENDING TIME TO
ANSWER OR OTHERWISE
RESPOND TO COMPLAINT**

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In ten of the above-captioned cases, a combined motion to dismiss is scheduled for hearing on March 23. This particular action, *Grinder v. Experian*, No. 3:17-cv-00343-WHA, is not a part of that combined motion. Defendants in this action, however, shall have until **28 DAYS** after the Court rules on the aforementioned combined motion to answer or otherwise respond to the complaint. The pending stipulated request to extend the time for defendant Wells Fargo Bank, N.A., to respond to the complaint (Dkt. No. 25) is **DENIED** as inconsistent with this order.
