15	On April 24, 2017, the court dismissed with leave to amend plaintiff's pro
16	se prisoner complaint under 42 U.S.C. § 1983 to allege, if possible, facts showing
17	that defendant: (1) knew that plaintiff faced a substantial risk of serious harm and
18	disregarded that risk by failing to take reasonable steps to abate it, and (2)
19	actually and proximately caused the deprivation of plaintiff's Eighth Amendment
20	rights. The court made clear that failure to file a proper amended complaint
21	within 28 days will result in the dismissal of this action.
22	On May 31, 2017, the court dismissed plaintiff's action because more than
23	28 days had passed and plaintiff had neither filed a proper amended complaint
24	nor sought an extension of time to do so.
25	On June 8, 2017, plaintiff filed a letter claiming that he never received the
26	April 24, 2017 order of dismissal with leave to amend. And several days later, he
27	filed a second letter to which he attached his prison mail log, showing that he
28	received no mail from the court during the moths of April or May 2017.

1	Good cause appearing therefor, the May 31, 2017 order of dismissal and
2	accompanying judgment (ECF Nos. 5 & 6) are VACATED, and the clerk is
3	instructed to reopen this case and send plaintiff a copy of the April 24, 2017 order
4	of dismissal with leave to amend.
5	Plaintiff may amend, as indicated in the April 24, 2017 order of dismissal
6	with leave to amend, within 28 days of this order. The pleading must be simple
7	and concise, and must include the caption and civil case number used in this
8	order and the words FIRST AMENDED COMPLAINT on the first page. Failure
9	to file a proper amended complaint within the designated time will result in the
10	dismissal of this action.
